Building Recovery-Ready Communities

The Ogle/DeKalb ROSC Council, led by **Sauk Valley Voices of Recovery**, works to reduce stigma, strengthen partnerships, and improve access to recovery support throughout DeKalb and Ogle Counties.

FY2026 PRIORITIES

Reduce Stigma

- Launched the **Recovery Lives Here** campaign.
- Featured recovery stories through bus stop billboards and six months of local radio advertisements.

Improve Service Coordination

- Developed and implemented Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with community service providers to strengthen referral pathways.

Expand Deflection

- Continued the **Project HOPE** partnership with the DeKalb Police Department, connecting **50+ individuals** to recovery support instead of the traditional justice system.
